Despite the small package, the TDR782 can handle numerous applications utilizing one of seven timing scales for precise programming with durations ranging from 0.1 second up to 100 hours.

The power on delay time function postpones power transfer when the control voltage is applied to the relay. Applications such as automatic hand dryers with motion sensors utilize this format to minimize false starts until a known and required state exists to warrant the initiation of current.
